This donation was considered as meeting KABC’s charter because Pave the Way has significant programming centered around KMS athletics and this dinner event will help promote Pave the Way.*

TEAM REQUESTS

Boys Swimming – *KABC By-Laws were reviewed with respect to Section 9.1 and 9.2 Awards. The current wording involves players and coaches on a team, or as an individual, winning the league, divisional, sectional championship, district or state championship shall receive up to a maximum....” This wording does not provide a clear definition for participants in individual sports (such as swimming, track and wrestling) who qualify for these more advanced levels of competition but do not win 1st place. KABC will review this wording to expand it and agreed to grant an individual award to Emils Jucik for advancing to the state competition for swimming.*

Track – *Requested funding for one additional bus to provide transportation from KMS to KHS for athletes. KMS may only fund one bus and the program has outgrown that one bus. This is estimated at 21 days with an expected maximum cost of \$750. KABC funding of this cost was approved up to the \$750 max. if KMS does not directly fund the cost for this second bus.*
