OLD BUSINESS

Mushroom Festival – Proposed Team Allocations – Total Allocations = \$5,350.

Full share (14 Teams) - \$300 – Cheer, Cross Country (1/2 share girls & 1/2 share boys), Track (1/2 share girls & 1/2 share boys), Field Hockey, Friends of Music, Football, golf, Ice Hockey, Boys Lax, Girls Soccer, Swimming (1/2 share girls & 1/2 share boys), boys tennis, girls tennis, volleyball

Half Share (5 Teams) - \$150 – boys basketball, girls lax, robotics, softball, wrestling (weak but improved on 2017)
